## **Additional Bank Account Option**

## TO ALL EMPLOYEES - PAYROLL

You have the **option** to have your banking institution set up a savings account besides your regular direct deposit account or use an already existing savings account, and payroll can set a flat amount or a percentage of your direct deposit into this extra account to allow you to save money. Some employees already have a second account which they use to accumulate some monies to set aside for when they take a vacation or to buy something you want to save for.

As an **example**, if you wanted \$200.00 every month to go to a savings account, we would split it so that \$100.00 of your advance pay and \$100.00 of your month end pay would go into this other account. Unfortunately we cannot pull this amount from just the month end pay. Once you set it for the amount you want, it pulls on every pay run. But you can pick whatever amount you would like to go into this new account. If you only want \$50.00 we would split that in two for \$25.00 for each pay.

If you pick a percentage instead as an **example**, if you wanted 10% every month to go to a savings account, we would split it so that 5% of your advance pay and 5% of your month end pay would go into this account. Your choice.

If this is an option you would like to choose, you only have to go to your banking institution and request a new account and a slip from the bank to hand into payroll so the correct account information is set up properly. This slip is also required if you want to use an existing savings account.
